DIRECTOR OF MUSIC

St. Paul's Anglican Cathedral, 1861 McIntyre Street in Regina is seeking a Director of Music whose duties will commence on 1st June 2018.

In general terms the following are the duties of the position:

Selecting the hymns, the Eucharistic setting, the psalm setting and the anthem to match the lectionary.

Conducting the cathedral choir in rehearsal and in the services. The choir is present for the 10-30am service each Sunday of the lectionary year from September until June. There are some additional services notably in Advent and Lent: rehearsals are on Thursdays from 7-30pm until 9-30pm; an accompanist is available.

Consulting with the Dean, the Deacons and the Organists on the music programme. The cathedral has a roster of three organists.

Engaging in general administration in association with the cathedral office with respect to the music programme.

A stipend is paid for this position.
